TECHNOLOGY HELPING NATURE

Nature Playground Parkville: Nature Play is a high-traffic playground. The client wanted a natural-looking grass surface below the play equipment on the bank.

The existing grass was wearing due to the concentrated traffic between the two ropes and mulch would just migrate down the hill. Ruts were opening up and creating a deep bank which was unsafe for play. We filled the ruts with sand, installed new sod and Cover Lawn over the top. The grass allowed to integrate with the Cover Lawn for 6 weeks before opening to the public, with only watering for maintenance. The area has shown no signs of rutting after 12 months of use.



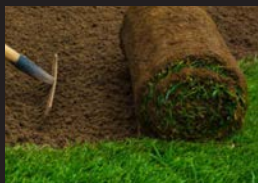

EASY INSTALLATION



01 Preparation

Cover Lawn can be installed over existing grass or newly laid grass. If using on an existing grass area, prepare the lawn by mowing at the lowest setting. Stretch the Cover Lawn over the lawn area.



02 Installation

Secure the edges by pushing the edge of the Cover Lawn into the grass with either a flat spade or blade. Secure the lawn down with pins. Top dress the area with whitewashed sand.



03 Care

Do not allow traffic on the area until the grass has integrated into the Cover Lawn. Monitor when mowing to ensure the Cover Lawn does not move. If so, tuck back into the soil. Avoid mowing the lawn too low to avoid entanglement with loose material.
